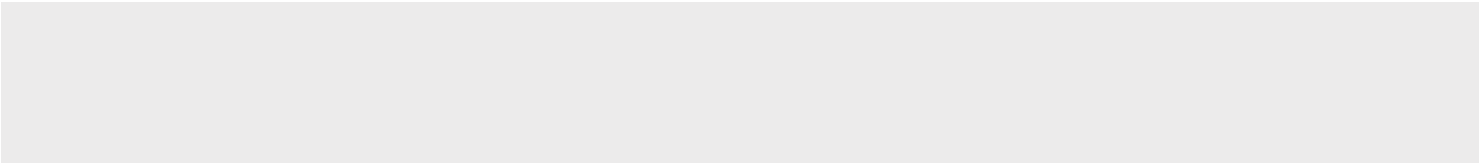
Volunteer Kansas has a vision of moving Kansas to number one in the country for volunteerism. Kansas is currently ranked number seven.
